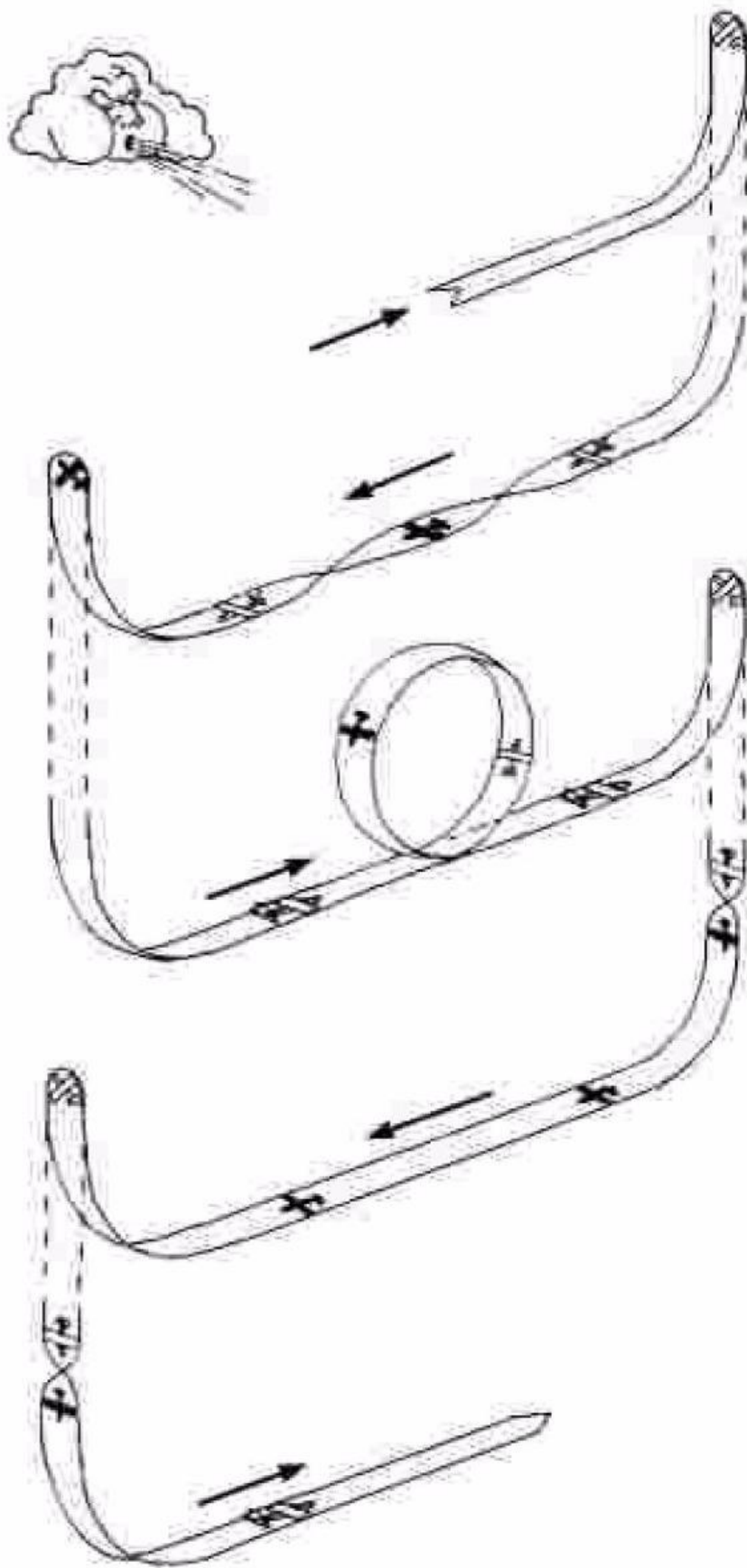


# The Half-Pipe Pattern



Competitor enters the flying box from either side, straight and level, before reaching the end of the box, performs a stall turn, coming back into the box, performs one roll on the centre line followed by a stall turn, flying back into the box, an inside loop is performed on the centre line followed by pulling up into a stall turn, halfway down this stall turn, pilot will roll 180 degrees and then at the bottom of the stall turn PUSH to level but inverted flight across the flying box to then PUSH to perform an outside stall turn, halfway down the pilot will roll 180 degrees and then at the bottom of that stall turn PULL to level upright flight across the box and exit – complete.

Each base line may vary in height provided all manoeuvres are within the flying box.
